

 - ii. Course(s) where assessing took place.
 - iii. Assessment used in those courses.
 - iv. When were results communicated to team/unit?
 - v. How where the results of the assessment used?
 - vi. Continue with learning outcome?
 - 1. If yes, explain.
 - 2. If no, explain.
 - c. Repeat both of these above for EACH learning outcome assessed.
